1. What is the time and date of the next auction?

2. How do I register to become a BIDDER at the upcoming auction?

NOTE:

Please register as early as possible, so that the auction team can contact you if there are any questions.

BIDDER REGISTRATION CLOSES 30 MINUTES PRIOR TO THE START OF THE AUCTION.

3. How do I submit a lot for consideration to SELL at auction?

You can submit a lot for consideration using the following form:

If you want to submit a lot of e.g. 5 cards as ONE lot, please put details of all 5 in ONE form.

Filling out the form multiple times leads to different lot submissions, which are difficult to keep track of.

NOTE:

Not every lot submitted will be accepted for the auction immediately, and lots which aren't accepted will be considered for subsequent auctions. Curating an auction is similar to formatting a DJ set, it must be smooth and have a good flow.

If your submitted lot is accepted into auction, you will be contacted via e-mail to transfer the goods into escrow prior to the auction and prior to your lot being announced here: https://t.me/nftlots

4. Where does the auction take place?

The auction takes place on Telegram, and includes both a text and voice portion.

ALL BIDS MUST BE SUBMITTED VIA TEXT, IN THE BIDDING ROOM, TO BE ACCEPTED AS VALID.

Registered bidders will receive a link to the private bidding room prior to the auction. This room is for BIDDING ONLY, and all messages will be immediately forwarded via a bot to the public NFT Auctions room. The voice portion of the auction will take place in the public NFT Auctions room.

PLEASE use the private room for BIDDING ONLY.

All discussion, stickers, gifs and shitposting should remain in PUBLIC room.

5. How do I pay for my goods if I win a lot?

After each lot is sold, an auction team member will update the lot listing in https://t.me/nftlots with payment details.

Every lot has a unique payment address. If you plan on bidding on (and winning) multiple lots, payment must be sent separately for each lot, to the specific payment address for that lot.

6. How do I receive my goods once I pay for a lot that I've won?

Goodman Auction escrow will contact buyers via e-mail within 48 hours of the auction close to arrange for the delivery of goods.

7. Will the price of my goods be affected due to BTC/ETH volatility?

A screenshot will be posted at the start of the auction displaying the current BTC and ETH price. All sales will be pegged to that USD value of BTC and ETH.
