

The 78Qth Military Intelligence Brigade Dig

I believe I have found the oldest Q Proof to date, and even Pepe in the same graphic. This Q Proof dates back to sometime between Feb 2014 and Sept 2015.

This Q proof appears to show us that the 780th MIB is the brigade behind the Q operation, and from this we get a new rabbit hole to go down and more pieces of the puzzle of how this whole White Hat Offensive that we are witnessing has unfolded.

I came across this through work when I came into contact with a member of the 780th Military Intelligence Brigade through a brief phone call. Being a Q follower since summer 2018, I immediately looked up the 780th brigade after hanging up with the person. I found their website, which is extremely basic, but contains some very interesting things that have peaked my interest.

I'm sharing with the Pepe Project to get more eyes on to hopefully make more connections. Then, I hope it spreads to open more eyes to Q, RARE PEPE's, and the ultimate signal, which is that Bitcoin is our military weapon to fight the central bank cabal.

Keep in mind I am just spitballing here and laying everything out there to be dug further. It definitely seems significant to me and I hope others will think so, too. Below is everything I have dug so far.

The 780th MIB Website

Besides the simplicity and old school vibes of the website, the first thing that caught my eye was the emblem with the Key, the lighting bolt, and arrow.

The Key gave me Q vibes.

The Lightning gave me BTC vibes

And since softwar is top of mind right now, the Arrow gave me softwar vibes. So I keep digging.



I checked out the [History page](#) next. A few interesting things here. First is the brigade activation date of **10/1/2011**, which I considered an 11 11 hit. **This date comes up later.**

The 780th Military Intelligence (MI) Brigade (Cyber) was activated on **October 1, 2011** as a Major Subordinate Command under the U.S. Army Intelligence & Security Command, while also serving under the operational control of U.S. Army Cyber Command (ARCYBER). The 780th MI Brigade is **the only operational offensive cyberspace Brigade in the U.S. Army**, where we actively fight alongside our Joint partners to achieve U.S. supremacy in an increasingly contested **cyberspace and electromagnetic domain**.

I also found it interesting that it is the “only offensive cyberspace brigade in the US Army” ... at the surface you think hackers, but the Q operation could also be considered an offensive cyber operation.

The fact that they highlight Electromagnetic domain is interesting.

Lets keep going.

Also in the history section, we find the Roots of 780th battalion are with the 742nd and 744th Military Intelligence AKA Army Network Warfare Battalion. This *Network Warfare* battalion was established in 2007 and 2008, right before Satoshi Nakamoto dropped the Bitcoin Whitepaper. Sounds pretty #softwar-ish.

In June 2000, Detachment Meade, 742nd MI Battalion was established to sustain the growing need for an Army computer network operations force. Detachment Meade was re-designated as the Army **Network Warfare Detachment** in **2007** and in **June 2008** the Task Force was again re-designated as the Army Network Warfare Battalion (Provisional). The following year the Battalion moved beyond its provisional status and was designated the 744th MI Battalion (Army Network Warfare Battalion).

Later in the history section we find the 915th was recently re-designated as the 11th Cyber Battalion... another 11 hit. Also talking about electronic warfare

On June 6, 2018, the Department of the Army directed ARCYBER to activate the 915th Cyber Warfare Battalion (915th CWB) at Fort Gordon, Georgia. Subsequently, ARCYBER directed the 780 MI Brigade to assume Command Authority and Administrative Control of the 915th CWB. On October 16, 2022, the 915th CWB was officially re-designated as the **11th Cyber Battalion (11th CYB)**. The 11th CYB is the first **scalable** organic expeditionary capability to meet the Army's current and projected tactical cyberspace requirements, including the integration of cyber and **electronic warfare**.

Ok so now I am combing through everything. I tried to get a closer look at the Emblem by saving the image but I couldn't right click save like normal. So I go to the source code (I do some web design), which reveals that the website the simplest as possible HTML coding. Most websites have tons of extra code in them. This is extremely bare bones and clean.

After struggling a bit to isolate the logo image, I finally, I realize the emblem is part of the larger background image, which is a VERY interesting image. Here is where I find the Q Proof.

If you look in the center, there is vertical letters spelling 780th Military Intelligence Brigade, but the 0 is a Q. There are also many other interesting characters that printed vertically but I haven't really found anything else meaningful in these.

Also, Longbranch pointed out there appears to be a pepe. Also very intriguing to me is the tagline "Everywhere and Always... In The Fight." especially with the ... placed where it is, but I don't know what to make of it.

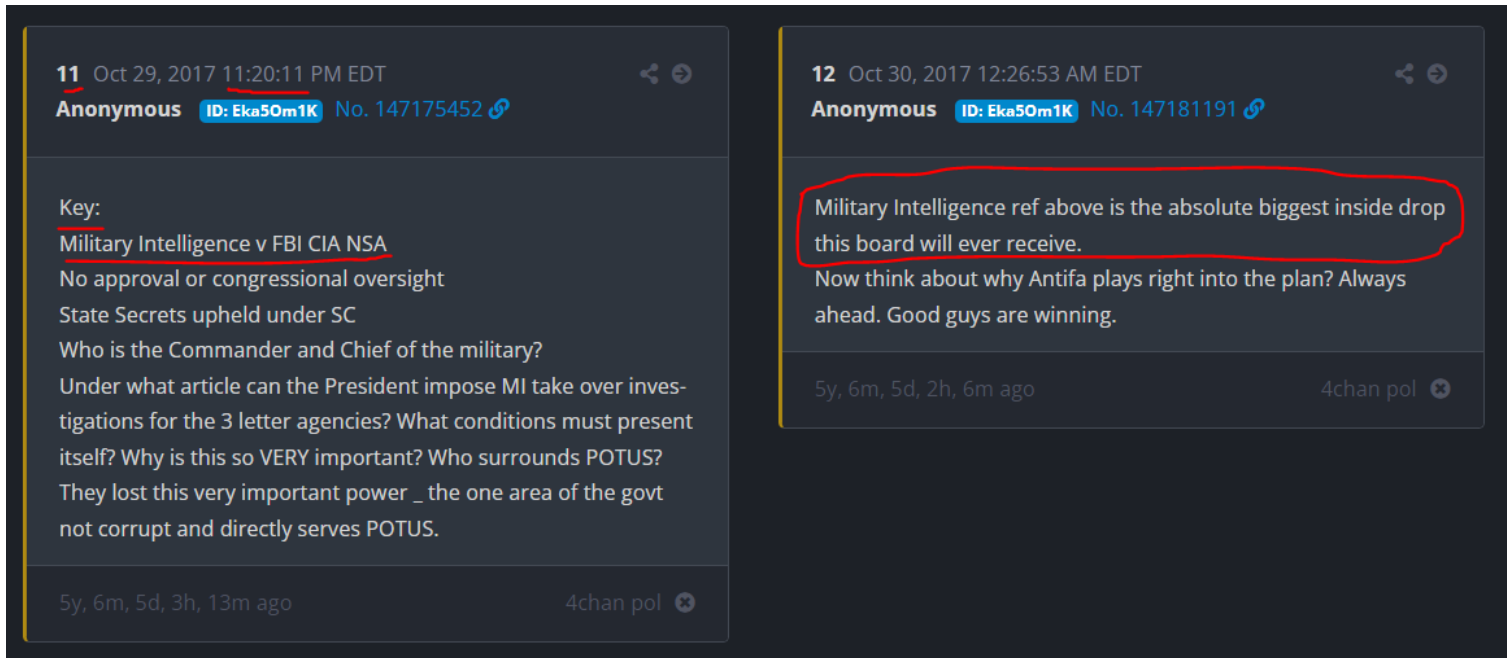


Q- Hits

Next I start digging through the Q posts. I remember “Key” being a common theme, so that is the first thing I search.

Q [post 11](#).

Post 11 timestamp is nearly a direct hit for the activation date for 780th. 10/1/2011 >> 11:20:11 and it also states “Key: Military Intelligence...”

Another Key hit. Key Planned for 3 Years”



Future proves past.
NOTHING is a coincidence.
The MAP is the KEY.
PLANNED for [3] years.
CORRUPTION and EVIL DEEP WITHIN.
EVERYWHERE.

Before I found this post, I looked at the 780th military brigade website on the Wayback Machine and I took note that they had a seemingly more robust [website in the early years of the battalion](#), and it later changed to the very simple website that is up today. After reading the Q post comment “planned for 3 years,” I wondered if they they changed the website and added the 78Q background image around Oct 2014 (3 year delta from when Q started in Oct 2017).


Sure enough, while I couldn't pin down the exact date, I found the background image added sometime between [Feb 18 2014](#) and [Sept 8 2015](#).

The Praetorians

Also interesting is the nickname Praetorians. Trump was using Military Intelligence instead of 3 letter agencies.
